Public input—Tracy Gilroy, of 3043 Shoreline Dr, Camano Island proposed "improving Shared Access to Sunrise Boulevard Properties." Ms. Gilroy indicated a May 5 deadline for feasibility. She is offering land and an access point as a contribution to a "shared partnership," but would require CIFR to provide the maintenance. Commissioner Evans and Chief Yengoyan committed to form a committee to meet with Ms. Gilroy further and indicated a desire to understand the full costs. Commissioner Williams indicated that CIFR would need to get legal opinions as well. Commissioner Treml also volunteered to be on the committee to further explore the issue.

- A. CIFR Admin Personnel Policy Handbook—Chief Yengoyan briefed the following proposed policy updates:
 - 1. Giving part-time admin the ability to earn partial holiday hours.
 - 2. Salary structure updates to a traditional step format with proposed salary increases based on comparable departments: Asst. Chiefs set to 115% of Captains wage with same longevity increases as everyone else. An increase for the Maintenance supervisor as comps show a deficiency.
 - 3. 17K overall increase to budget for salary adjustments.
 - 4. Chief Yengoyan requested approval at next board meeting.

Commissioner Williams requested further clarification and definition surrounding the salary steps be updated in the policy handbook.

B. Policy 369 Wildland Deployments—Chief Yengoyan briefed that Asst. Chief Allen has worked with the Union to come up with a mobilization process.
