Camano Fire serves a population of 17,000 in a 39-square-mile area. We provide advanced life

support and basic life support services, fire prevention, specialty rescue services, and public

education. We operate four stations, an administration office, and a maintenance facility. Our

crews respond to more than 2,500 calls each year, approximately 70 percent of which are EMS.

Our team includes three chief officers, 29 career firefighters, 12 part-time firefighters, 15

volunteer firefighters, three administrative staff, and three maintenance positions all governed by

a five-member Board of Commissioners.

Camano Island is 15 minutes west of I-5, accessed via State Route 532. Part of Island County,

Camano sits just across the bridge from the town of Stanwood, roughly 60 miles north of Seattle

and 30 miles south of Mount Vernon. Camano is an outdoor enthusiast's dream with two state

parks, miles of hiking trails, public beaches, and fishing and boating opportunities.

Additional Information: Lateral Entry candidates may be eligible for up to twenty (20) years of experience granted to them by the Fire Chief for the purpose of wages and vacation accrual for prior, full time firefighting experience. Lateral Entry candidates will serve a 6-month probation focused on Department specific materials. Recruit academy participation will be dependent on candidate's experience and prior academy participation. Candidates required to attend academy will have their start date for probation begin upon graduation from academy.

Each candidate must also complete the mandatory cover letter and application packet, available at the District website https://camanofire.com/get-involved/careers/, or the Administration Office located at 811 N Sunrise Blvd, Camano Island, WA. Paramedic candidates include in their cover letter a brief statement regarding your Rapid Sequence Intubation Training/Experience as well as outlining your Pediatric Intubation Training/Experience. We are also requesting a letter of recommendation from your current MPD or paramedic training program supervisor. Submit a resume, cover letter, MPD letter with your application, a copy of your Driver's License and copies of your certifications to the Administration Office by the end of the application period. September 30th at 4:00 PM.

Top candidates from the application process will be invited to an interview. Paramedic candidates will also participate in an assessment process.

Top candidates will be placed on the eligibility list and District may choose to utilize the eligibility list for up to one (1) year.
